Metropolitan Rifle Matches.

THE annual prize meeting of the Metropolitan Rifle Association, open to military district No. 4, was held at the Rideau range, Ottawa, on Friday and Saturday last, the shooting going on all day Friday and on Saturday afternoon. The attendance showed a slight falling off, the total number of competitors present being about forty. The weather was very unfavorable for high scoring, owing to varying wind and changeable light. The shooting was all with Snider rifles, and

the ammunition used, D.C., '87, came in for a good deal of blame, some of which at least was deserved, as the number of drop shots was very large. The executive officer was Lt.-Col. Bacon, vice-president of the association, and Color-Sergt. Cope, of the Guards, looked after the statistics.

In addition to the usual money prizes, the list this year included a handsome silver cup, the gift of His Worship Mayor Stewart of Ottawa, and a silver medal presented by His Excellency the Governor-General. For the extra series matches, which were open to all comers, without their having to pay membership fees, valuable prizes in kind, donated by merchants of Ottawa, were offered, as well as six cash prizes in each series. Amongst those who took advantage of the opportunity presented to fire in these was Pte. A. Gillies of the 90th, who had stopped over at Ottawa on his return from Wimbledon. Pte. Gillies put in four bulls and an inner at 500 yards, making 24 out of 25, which remained at the head until the close of the competition. The following were the prize winners in each match:—
