

The Canadian side took note of this, and will convey this interest to Dr Stolow.

The details will be determined through diplomatic channels.

48. Inasmuch as Mexico and Canada are signatories to the 1970 UNESCO convention concerning measures to be adopted in order to prevent and prohibit the illegal import, export, and transfer of items of cultural significance, both parties expressed their interest in carrying out specific cooperation and exchange projects in the areas of museums, archaeology, ethnology, history, and monument conservation.

As an initial step, each Party provided the other with information on its cultural-heritage legislation.

The specific projects will be made known through diplomatic channels.

V. AUDIOVISUAL MEDIA

RADIO, TELEVISION, AND FILM

49. The two countries will exchange catalogues of available audiovisual material on educational and cultural subjects.

50. The two countries will exchange records having folklore-related themes.

51. The two countries will support the signing of a cooperation agreement in the areas of television and film.
