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Marketing Profile

National Carpet Mills was started in 1968 and began producing PVC backed mats and runners for the sanitation industry. In 1970, the production of indoor/outdoor carpeting was added and the first broadloom were manufactured in 1974. The introduction of washable matting followed in the early eighties and, through constant expansion and addition of necessary machinery, National Carpet Mills is now in a position to supply a wide range of patterned and level loop carpeting for commercial and domestic application. In 1987, polypropylene extrusion capacity was acquired which recently has been expanded to a total capacity of approximately 10,000 tonnes per year.

The company is currently exporting matting products to markets in the U.K., Continental Europe, as well as the Far and Middle East. Indoor/outdoor carpets as well as broadloom are being exported to Australia and the Far East. National Carpet's principal export customers are distributors in the floor covering industry as well as suppliers to the building maintenance trade, mass merchandisers and the textile rental industry.

The company is interested in expanding its export markets on a global basis and through their director of export sales can communicate in French as well as German.
