EXCELLENCY,

I have the honour to refer to Your Excellency's Note No. 66 of this date, in which you make known your Government's interest in extending for an additional year, the *Modus Vivendi* regulating the commercial trade between Venezuela and Canada, originally signed in Caracas on October 11, 1950.

In relation to the details of your kind Note and taking into consideration the mutual benefits rendered by this *Modus Vivendi*, in strengthening the commercial relations between my country and Canada, I am pleased to inform you that my Government is in agreement with your esteemed Government's proposition, and accordingly has decided to renew the above-mentioned instrument for another year, commencing the 11th of October of the present year.

Likewise, I take pleasure in informing Your Excellency that my Government has authorized me to agree and sign the proposed renewal in its name, in accordance with the principles contained in the above-mentioned instrument.

This Note together with that of Your Excellency's may be considered as constituting an Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Venezuela and Canada.

I avail myself of the opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurances of my utmost consideration.
