Thursday, September 29.

- 11.10 a.m. Mr. van Zeeland arrives by train at the Ottawa Union Station.
- 1.00 p.m. Luncheon at the Belgian Embassy.
- 3.15 p.m. Mr. van Zeeland lays a wreath at the National War Memorial.
- 3.30 p.m. Calls on the Deputy Governor General at the Supreme Court Building.
- 4.00 p.m. Calls on the Speaker of the House of Commons.
- 4.15 p.m. Calls on the Speaker of the Senate.
- 4.30 p.m. Calls on the Prime Minister at the House of Commons (Room 201).
- 5.30 p.m. Reception by Belgium Ambassador at the Belgian Embassy.
- 8.00 p.m. Dinner by the Prime Minister on behalf of the government of Canada at the Country Club.

Friday, September 30

- 10.30 a.m. Press conference at the Belgian Embassy, 170 Laurier Ave. East.

Mr. van Zeeland will leave Ottawa for New York during the afternoon.

Mr. van Zeeland will be accompanied on his visit by Baron de Gruben, Secretary General of the Belgian Foreign Office.
