Budget, 3065. Amendment moved by Mr.

Ralston an expression of fiscal policy of Liberal party and a public pronouncement of their policy; lack of policy and lack of effort on part of King government to hold an export market for our wheat; treatment of wheat marketing problem by former administration; re-establishment of European pre-war production by 1925, 3065; outlook for wheat marketing greatly changed by agricultural policies of European countries in first post-war years; trends in wheat acreages in Europe from 1921 to 1930; Russia's activity in wheat growing; changes in average of wholesale wheat prices from 1925 to 1930; definite reaction of Canadian wheat prices as result of increased European acreage; new agricultural policies in Germany, Italy and France, and increase in import duties on foreign wheat, 3066; comparison of wheat prices in Germany, Italy and France as compared with Liverpool price; curtailment of wheat imports in European countries, and Canadian exports for 1932-33, 3067; foreign duties against wheat under King government and under present government; increase in our wheat carry over from 1925 to 1930; exports of live stock to United Kingdom from 1925 to 1930; loss of our market for agricultural products due to high tariffs in United States, 3068; serious condition confronting present government in 1930 in regard to export markets for agricultural products; efforts of the present government to regain our markets lost under the King administration, 3069; results obtained through operations of the Ottawa trade agreements, 3070
