Gentlemen: We have pleasure in submitting the attached plans and sketches, numbered 209-Al to A4 inclusive. showing, in a very general way, the additions under present consideration, both in relation to the existing building and to its ultimate developments. 2. We understand Dr. Lomer's requirements to be as follows: (a) Increase of existing stack by fifty per cent (50%) to meet (i) Present overcrowding; (ii) Use of part of present stack for administration, etc. (iii) Ten years increment. (b) A new Reading Room for two hundred (200) with a series of new Departmental Study Libraries. (c) Redistribution of space within the existing building affecting administration, International Catalogue, etc., etc., etc. We recommend the reservation of a part of the site available for library extensions for a stack of say half a million books.
