

From the persuasion I am in that the court of Vienna finds her own account in preservation, I have been more explicit on this whole subject with count Sternberg, who will not fail making a circumstantial report thereof by the same courier ; and as for the rest, I may trust to your understanding, your zeal and your skill, which will render unnecessary any addition to this letter, relative to all the reflections and essential motives suitable to this critical situation, and agreeable to the connections that subsist between both the courts.

I must only earnestly request your excellency to hasten as much as possible the eclaircissements which you may have to send me, being very truly, and with, &c.
