And your petitioners further say that the said Frederick Mackenzie during said election provided and furnished drink and other refreshments at the expense of said Frederick Mackenzie to divers electors, and further, the said Frederick Mackenzie paid for and procured and engaged to pay for drinks and other refreshments to divers other electors during said election to corruptly promote the same, whereby the said Frederick Mackenzie was and is guilty of corrupt praetiees, and was and is incapable of being a candidate, or of being elected or returned to the present Parliament, and should be declared incapable of being elected to and of sitting in the House of Commons during the seven years next after the date of his being proved or found guilty of said offenees, and the said election and return of the said Frederick Mackenzie were and are wholly null and void.
