### WICKSON WINS STEEPLECHASE

Long Shot Handily Defeats  
Favorite in Feature Race at  
Blue Bonnets—Rifle Bri-  
gade Best Two-Year-Old

MONTREAL, Sept. 11.—The racing at Blue Bonnets today attracted the largest crowd of the meeting, about 4000 being present.

As was expected, Floral Crown annexed the purse in the opening event, with the stable companion, King Saxe, second and Saloon third. Floral Crown and King Saxe, who finished within a few feet of each other, drew away after a good start and were never in danger.

Bay of Pleasure came right back again, winning easily in the second. Chenuipou, the favorite, was second and Tiddling third.

Bwana Tumbo proved that he is still in good shape, for he ran away from the field and was never seriously challenged. The feature event of the day, the Strathcona Steeplechase, was won by Wickson, owned by L. A. Ekers of Montreal. Notwithstanding Wickson's good performance on Saturday last, when he ran second at a long price, he was quite as good a lot of money was placed on him. Wickson was a steady race and won comfortably. Of the ten horses that started, only four finished. King Saxe, the favorite, was second and Chenuipou third. Hendrie's life brigade won the two-year-old race. Summary:
