AN ENGLISH REPORTER'S BALL GAME STORY

Canadians and Americans met in a baseball game at Lord's, London. Here is how the "expert" of the Morning Post reported the match:

The baseball rally at Lord's on Saturday, organized to raise funds for the widows and orphans of Canadian soldiers who fell in the war, was a great success. There was a very large company, and the exposition of America's national game given by members of the Canadian Imperial Contingent and London Americans was first class.

Some years have passed since Londoners have had the chance of seeing the real thing in American baseball. It was a strange spectacle for old prosaic Lord's, and the accompanying "music" of the game may have seemed a little discordant to the ears of those more accustomed to cricket.

THE DUKE OF ORLEANS REBUKES FERDINAND

Requests Bulgarian King to Take Back Jewels of Orders Bestowed Upon Him

Paris, Oct. 18.—The Duke of Orleans several days ago addressed a letter to King Ferdinand of Bulgaria, requesting the monarch to take back Jewels of Bulgarian orders which had been bestowed upon him, but the letter was to be published only on the day Bulgaria entered the war.

"The attitude Your Majesty has thought right to take in the present war, contrary to your previous policy, forces me to the sad duty of praying Your Majesty to take back the Jewels of the Golden Piece and refer to his marriage to the archduchess Marie Dorothea as the misfortune of my life."

The Duke of Orleans married the Archduchess Maria Dorothea of Austria in Vienna in November, 1896. She obtained a separation from him in Paris in July of last year, after domestic difficulties which had lasted for years.
