LIQUOR-CRAZED; HE OPENS SWITCH, WRECKS A TRAIN

Arrest of Foreigner at Wilno Leads to Discovery of Two Whiskey Stills.

Renfrew, Jan. 13.—As a result of investigations by David Sylvester, provincial license inspector, two large and fully equipped stills have been discovered in the vicinity of Wilno, about miles west of here on the Grand Trunk Railway. The stills had been in operation for some time, it is believed; but until the arrest of a Pole half crazed

with blind pig whiskey, all efforts of the provincial officers had not resulted in discovery of their location. Both stills were capable of turning out large quantities of crude whiskey. They were operated, it is believed, by two or possibly three Poles, for whom Inspector Sylvester is now searching.

The discovery of the stills came about in an unusual manner. On Friday a Pole, who later gave the name of Yanda, is said to have staggered out on the Grand Trunk tracks at Wilno and opened the switch just as a freight train bound for Ottawa slowed into the station. The freight was partly thrown off the tracks, but no injuries to the crew resulted and the cars were pulled back on the rails again shortly after.

Yanda was found, half-blinded by liquor, staggering sinuously about near the track after the wreck. He was arrested, and in police court on the following morning was fined \$200 and costs by Police Magistrate Devine for breach of the Ontario Temperance Act. He is now confined in the local jail, pending trial on the more serious charge of attempting to wreck. In court he told of obtaining liquor from the operator of a blind pig at that place, and following Yanda's directions, located the stills. He is continuing the search for the owners of the outfit. A friend of Yanda is believed to have been implicated.
