Niagara Falls, Ont., July 10—Charles Stephens, the Bristol barber, who announced some time ago that he planned a trip over the falls in a barrel, has arrived here and is looking over the proposed route to fame and fortune. He spent several days in Toronto dickering with moving picture people preparatory to his making the trip down stream from the brink of the cataract.

Stephens looks to be a man of sixty summers. He is of decidedly English type, tall and of slight build. He has not the earmarks of a daredevil, is mild of manner, gray-haired, with gray eyes and a softly modulated voice. He does not impress one as the one to essay the part he has assigned to himself. He is uncommunicative and declined to discuss the proposed venture. He said he feared an attempt might be made by the Canadian authorities to prevent his attempting the feat from Canadian soil and that he may go to the American shore to fulfill his contract, if it can be arranged.
