### LABOR COUNCIL

A meeting of the Trades and Labor Council was held last night. It was largely attended and delegates were received from three new unions, namely, the sheet metal workers, the civic employees and the machinists. The matter of holding a fair on Labor Day was discussed and a committee appointed to make arrangements. With reference to the matter published in a hardware journal, one dealing with the standardization of the price of muscle and the value of brains, and the other dealing with daylight saving, a resolution was adopted, to the effect that organized labor would strenuously resist and oppose any attempt to insinuate untruths regarding the policy and purposes of the trades union movement and giving assurance to the journal that they would standardize the value of muscle, even as the price of muscle was standardized.
