ARRESTED FOR LARCENY.

Frank Harding of St. John and a Portuguese lad.

Yesterday afternoon considerable excitement was occasioned on Centre street by a man named Frank Harding.

The man was driving at a rapid rate and collided with a carriage in which a lady was seated.

The police officers were on the spot in the evening that Officers Nickerson and Knable found the man in West Market square.

A young fellow who was with him at the time a Portuguese, about eleven years old, was also placed under arrest.

At the time Harding was arrested, he had three pairs of pantaloons and his cap turned round side out.

An investigation of matters during the day has brought to light the facts concerning Harding and the Portuguese, that on the trial at the court this afternoon will undoubtedly show a tendency of making it up with them.

Goods are alleged to have been stolen by these two men from James A. Robins's store, 3, Waterman, Ferry & Frost, to Oak & Clark, Charles S. Jones and A. F. Bradfield, out of changes to make.

Harding came to this city Saturday morning from a Boston, where he had been with him in telling his story.

Harding had only been in the country three months and his command of the English language is not enough to enable him to give a satisfactory account of the alleged stealing of the goods.

Concerning the alleged stealing of the goods, the facts as gleaned from the officers handling with the boy, are as follows: A Boston boy, who had purchased an outfit, as there was not one of the right size and style in the city, left them and went to the second store.

During his absence the two men matched a pair of pantaloons and made a pair of shoes.

They were taken and sent to the second store, where they were wearing apparel.
