

Two Boys Describe the Journey Made by Brooklyn Doctor.

"They, with Dr. Cook, Franche and nine other Eskimos left Anaktok, crossed Smith's Sound to Cape Sabine, and then returned. Peary's old house in Peary Harbor was used as a store. Rice Strait to Buchanan Bay. After a few marches Franche and three Eskimos returned to Anaktok. Dr. Cook with the others then proceeded by Peary Bay, a narrow channel between Buchanan Bay and Cape Elizabeth, and through the valley pass indicated by Commander Peary in 1898 and utilized by Sverdrup in 1899 to the head of Sverdrup's Bay Fjord, on the west coast of Somerset Land. Their route lay out through the flat, treeless north through Sverdrup's Houderk and Hansen Strait. On their way they killed muskoxen and bear and made caches, arriving eventually at a point
