

SECTION XI.—LIBRARY, MUSEUMS, AND APPARATUS.

§ 1.

UNIVERSITY LIBRARY

(INCLUDING THE COLLEGE LIBRARY).

The Library contains a small but valuable collection of works in the different departments of science and literature. The number of volumes is about 13,000, and the selection has been made mainly with a view to their practical utility as books of reference.

The Library is open every day (excepting Sunday) from 10 to 3 o'clock, and the College Students are admissible.

§ 2.

UNIVERSITY MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY.

(INCLUDING THE COLLEGE MUSEUM.)

This Museum contains in Mammalia above 70 specimens, affording examples of most of the orders, and including some rare and highly interesting species, besides skulls, horns, &c.

Of Birds there are nearly 1000 species, including a very large proportion of the native birds, and illustrations of most of the recognised tribes, besides many eggs and nests.

Of Reptiles there are about 70 species; and of Fishes there are about 150, with some skeletons.
