#### TRADES FAIR TO DOMESTIC HELP CONSIDERED

York County Council Takes up Burden of Providing Domestic Servants.

Fredericton, Jan. 8.—At this afternoon's session of the York County Council, Councillor Robert Graham, of Prince William, drew attention to the prevailing difficulty in this country of securing domestic servants, and introduced a resolution calling upon the im migration authorities to take steps to bring domestic servants from Europe. Councillor Graham withdrew his resolution to frecast ft, but will reintroduce it later. The coupcil ordered bills of the old Board of Health paid, in order that the new board will begin its official year with no debts outstanding.

Some councillors advocated the discontinuance of the two and a half percent. discount on taxes, on the ground that it was deducted from the fees of the county, was resulting in complaints from the collectors, that they must receive greater recompense or they will resign. The matter will be considered further.
