Study of Wilde's Boxing Attitude

Boxing Pose of Jimmy Wilde Should be Studied by All Youngsters Who Hope to Succeed in the Ring.

The boxing pose of Jimmy Wilde should be studied by all youngsters who hope to succeed in the ring. This distinctive champion when he faces an opponent assumes an attitude that is absolutely perfect, and it is not the Jim Macos pose either. Wilde's feet are planted solidly on the ring floor, with the toes toward his opponent, while the right toe is at right angles to the left, with the heel slightly off the floor. The left knee is bent slightly, but the right leg is rigid. The weight is on the left leg. The body and head are slightly inclined forward, although the head is held up, his eyes looking straight into those of his opponent.

It is the position of the arms and hands that attract the attention of close students of ring science. The left arm is bent at the elbow and the shoulder down is held rather close to the body, but not in a cramped position. The hand and forearm are extended and point the body of the opposing boxer, the knuckle part of the glove being uppermost. Thus the left arm is in position either to strike quickly or to parry a blow.

The right arm also is bent at the elbow, the upper arm being held close to the body, while the forearm and glove are slightly raised so as to protect the stomach from attack and at the same time be in position to shoot out, for the body or jaw of an opponent.

In fact, Wilde's position insures perfect freedom of action for feet or hands, and the facility with which he hits with either hand from any angle, coupled with the agility with which he avoids blows aimed at him, proves that his system is a liberal education for the majority of American boxers, who their left hand straight out so that it takes time to bring it into defensive position or draw it back for attack.

The right hand usually is held in a cramped position, it becomes tired and it cannot be used to its full advantage.

In standing the boxer too often leans back, a fatal fault, or crouches forward, which is nearly as bad. Watching Wilde in action, a liberal education to a young boxer, and his system should be taught to the novices.

Forty-Nine For King's Plate Race

Largest Entry in Years for Oldest Annual Thoroughbred Event on Continent.

Toronto, March 24.—Forty-nine thoroughbreds have been named for the King's Plate of 1920, the oldest fixture on the continent, on this date. It will be run this year on Saturday, May 22, the opening day of racing at Woodbine Park. While the individual entries are not available, Secretary W. P. Fraser states that the entry is the largest in years. He also states that not only is the entry greater, but the number of individual owners is greater, too. The King's Plate has \$7,500 of added money and also \$50,000 of the gift of His Majesty King George V. The King's Plate is for three-year-olds and upwards, foaled, raised and trained in Canada. It has never won a race either on the flat or across country, other than a race exclusively for two-year-olds.

The distance is one mile and a quarter. The Stanley Produce Stakes of 1922, entries for which closed on March 12, has an entry of 46, as compared with 38 in 1916, the last time the race was run. This shows the effect the ban on racing has had on breeding in Canada. The breeders' Stakes of 1921 has an entry of 37, while the Maple Leaf Stakes, which will also be run in 1921, has an entry of 19.

BOSTON BOOKMAKERS SEEK NEW FIELDS

Boston, Mass., March 24.—The local "bookies" who heretofore have concentrated their efforts on horse racing have now entered the field of golf, and there is considerable resentment among players of the game. The bookmakers are making up sheets on the big tournaments being played in the South. In the recent tournament at Belleair, Florida, for the West Coast championship, they quoted Walter Hagen at 6 to 1 for the place, 2 to 1 for second, and even money for third. The same quotations applied for Alex. Smith, the British professional. Literature has been circulated containing the invitation to inquire about the prices on coming tournaments. It is not unlikely that the golfers here will be stirred to action against the practice.

MITCHELL AND DUNCAN WILL NOT VISIT STATES

New York, March 24.—Official confirmation that Alvin Mitchell and George Duncan, the British professional golfers, will not accompany Harry Vardon and Ted Ray to America to engage in the Baltusrol team matches and other events this summer has been received by Alex. Pirie, secretary of the Professional Golfers' Association. The cable message from Robert Pirie, of London, secretary of the British Professional Golfers' Association, states simply: "Duncan and Mitchell unable to play in America."

MANY SEEKING BENNY LEONARD'S TITLE OF LIGHTWEIGHT CHAMPION

Present Situation in the Lightweight Ranks Fully Described—Jackson and Tondler Lead in a Formidable List of the Capable Lightweight Who Menace Crown of the Champion.

Charles F. Mathison in the New York Sun has the following review of the situation in the lightweight ranks: The lightweight division of pugilism in this country is the only class in which the crown of the champion is menaced by formidable contenders for the honors. It does not follow that any one contender is a sure thing to wrest the title from Benny Leonard, but it cannot be denied that the list of aspirants contains several boxers of the first rank. Leonard, who is not a fighter, has frequently won reported the competition for the title would develop a series of the greatest lightweight contests ever seen in America.

As the case stands there now is a very pretty scramble in progress among the 135 pounders for the honor of a meeting with the champion. Willie Jackson of New York and Low Tondler of Philadelphia appear to be in the lead at the present time, and as there is a strong probability of a contest between them the question as to the identity of Leonard's next title bout may soon be determined.

There is considerable question as to the relative merits of Jackson and Tondler. They have met twice in the ring and while the Quaker received the better of the points in each bout, the performance of the New Yorker was such as to create the impression that under different conditions he might be more successful. Jackson's work against Dundee showed that the boxer, who is boxing and hitting in the best form of his career and that he would be a dangerous opponent even for the peerless Leonard, who, until recently, was a heavy featherweight, has filled out and now looks like a security in the ring.

There can be no question that a contest between Tondler and Jackson would be one of the most interesting tests between the pair created in the history of the sport. The promoter who stages it will assure himself of popular approbation, and the press will be full of praise for the best efforts of the pugilists who entered the ring. With a match for the title hanging on victory it is unlikely that either of the boys would withhold the full force of his blows. One thing that Jackson and Tondler should at once do is to stop the senseless twaddle about fighting for the title at 135 raps. The limit of the class all over the world is 135 pounds, and Dundee is the only lightweight in this country who now can weight below 135 pounds and retain his strength.

Olympic Methods In U.S. and England

United States and England Need About Same Amount of Money, \$150,000, to Place Teams in Games at Belgium.

It is a singular coincidence that the United States and England need about the same amount of money—\$150,000—to prepare and maintain athletic teams for the approaching Olympic games at Belgium. What is still more singular is that both countries are going about procuring the money in the same way. Public subscription will play a major part in the collection of the cash here and there, and while there is nothing new in the method on this point, the Atlantic is having its first test in the land of the British.

Ever since the modern Olympic revival developed in 1896 the English, crowned at the American idea of sending around the hat to send the athletic team abroad, it was dignified and savored of professionalism. Now the British are doing the same thing and it is one more instance of the spread of American methods.

WILDE TO REMAIN THREE MONTHS

New York, March 24.—Jimmy Wilde expects to stay in the United States three months more. He has become acclimatized and is fighting at his best. His next opponent may be Paddy O'Garty, the New York bantam, who scales 114 pounds raps. He is billed to meet "Bad News" Elmer, the Canadian bantam champion, at Windsor, Ont., at the end of this month, for a purse of \$5,000.

TORONTO OARSMAN PICKS CAMBRIDGE

London, March 24.—Captain Allan Poynter, a well-known Toronto oarsman, who has seen both the university crews at their preparatory work for the boat race next September, says that the best race next September will be between Cambridge, with four of last year's winning crew, including stroke and number seven, shows considerable better form than Oxford. The combined coaching of Steve Parfitt and Arthur should give them the victory. Harrier, the Cambridge stroke, has developed a chip.
