

Recommended, in view of the billeting fund not being required this year, that the sum of 25c. only be accepted from the "W's," the "Y's" not paying anything this year. The proceeds to be applied to payment of all necessary local expenses, the balance, if any, to be applied to Miss Sproule's work.

Recommended, that in future the sum of 25c. only be required from each "W" and "Y" for the billeting fund.

Further Recommended, that if at any time there be a surplus, it may be applied in any way the Convention would deem wise.

Recommended, in view of the unusually heavy programme we will be obliged to decline Miss Chown's kind offer to lay before Convention the question of Household Economics.

Recommended that as various petitions are already afloat and championed by our workers, that we do not, as a Union, circulate the petition praying for the prohibition of liquor and opium to native races.

Recommended, that we place on record our heartfelt sympathy with our Quebec sisters in the above effort, and pledge ourselves to do all in our power to further its interests when it reaches us through the churches.

Recommended, that we heartily endorse the memorial from Minnesing, praying that each member of local Unions pay not less than 10c. into the fund for Mission Work among Lumbermen.

THIRD DAY.

Convention opened at 9:30 a. m. The President in the chair.

Mrs. Bryan, of Lucknow, conducted devotional exercises, reading the 37th Psalm.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and, on motion, adopted.

The minutes of the Executive Board were read and, upon motion and after discussion, were adopted.

Miss Wiley, Corresponding Secretary pro tem, called the roll, 106 delegates responding, also 23 officers, superintendents and county presidents.
