Effect Follows Cause If there is one law of the universe more

invariable in its operation than any other, it is that which says that no person, or aggregation of persons, may work an injustice upon another individual, or aggregation of individuals, without having to pay the penaltynot only the generation which perpetrates the iniquity, but succeeding generations until the scales are balanced, and in some cases it would appear that the balance is exceeded in the direction of requital.

As a case in point, take the treatment which the people of the American colonies, and later the United States, meted out to the negroes when they were ruthlessly torn from their native land and carried away as so many chattels to become the slaves of the white man. Because of that injustice, the people of the United States were torn by four years of bloody civil war, which resulted in freeing the negro, but which could not elevate him to the full status of citizenship in the greater part of that country.

The negro has a vote, but he dare not exercise it in any of the states of the South today. As a result of the injustice done years ago, riots and lynchings occur with alarming frequency in many parts of the United States.

The negro has put the brand of Cain upon the people who enslaved him, and it will be many generations before they escape. In fact, it is hard to see where the fates of these two races, which were brought together by Man's inhumanity to Man, will ever again become disassociated.

He is also slowly merging his blood with that of his white neighbors, and, while it may not be noticeable for generations, the time will ultimately arrive when the features of the typical American of that day in certain parts of the United States, will bear greater resemblance to the Ethiopian ancestor than to the Caucasian

Ireland and Poland are other instances of the working out of the same Law, and it does not take much prescience to predict that similar retribution will follow the action of the Peace Conference, particularly in the case of Shantung, in the name of Humanity.
