from Mechan-mitted a statement, under the corporate seal of such Institute or Assoics' Institutes ciation, and verified by the written declaration of the Secretary transmitting the same, of the names of all members on the roll of each
Mechanics' Institute who are working mechanics or manufacturers, and
are paying an annual subscription of at least one dollar each to the 5And Art Asfunds of such Institute, and the names of all the members on the roll
of each Art Association, who are paying an annual subscription of at
least two dollars each to the funds of such Association;

If any Institution has elected too many delegates.

3. If it appears by the said statement that any Mechanics' Institute or Art Association has elected too many delegates, then the Secretary 10 of the Board shall abstain from recording any of the names of the delegates of such Institution or Association, and shall submit the matter to the Board at its first meeting; and the said Board may, if it see fit, adjudge that such Mechanics' Institute or Art Association shall not be entitled to any delegate for the year then next ensuing, or may 15 decide by vote or ballot which delegate or delegates shall be rejected; and in this latter case the names of the remaining delegate or delegates shall be forthwith inscribed on the roll of members; and no person shall be held to be a member of such Board during any year whose name shall not have been inscribed on such roll, or demand for such inscription 20 made, on or before the twentieth day of January of that year.

Penalty for fake statements, &c. 4. The wilful making of any false statement or declaration required or authorized by this Act shall be a misdemeanor, punishable by fine or imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court.

MEETINGS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARDS.

Balf-yearly meetings. 78. The said Boards of Arts and Manufactures shall meet at the 25 cities of Toronto and Montreal respectively, twice in every year, that is to say, on the last Tuesday in the month of January and July, if such Tuesday be not a holiday; but if it be a holiday the meeting shall take place the next day thereafter, not being a holiday;

Special meetings.

2. And the President of either of the said Boards, and in his absence 30 from the Province, or, in the case of a vacancy in the office of President, then the Vice-President, whenever he deems it necessary or is required by any ten members thereof so to do, shall call a special meeting of the same, in the interval between any two meetings:

Notice.

3. But no such special meeting shall take place until seven clear days 35 after a written or printed notice signed by the Secretary of the Board, and specifying the day, hour and place of meeting, and the object or objects for which the same is called, has been mailed to the address of each member of the Board, whose name is inscribed on the roll as such member.

President, Officers and Council. 79. Each of the said Boards shall, at its regular meeting in January of each year, elect from among its members a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer, to hold office for the ensuing year, or until the election of their successors; and shall elect a Council of not less than five nor more than nine of their number, for the management during the 45 year of such affairs of the Board as may by any By-law be entrusted to them;
