



Notre Dame Church.

Facing Place d'Armes Square, is one of the principal landmarks of Montreal. Its seating capacity is nearly 12,000. The towers are 227 feet high, in one of which is the great bell, "Le Gros Bourdon," which weighs 29,400 pounds. Ten other large bells are in the opposite tower, and eighteen men are required to ring them. The church was erected in 1829. The length of the church is 225 feet and about 135 feet wide. Visitors can ascend to the top of one of the towers by means of an elevator.
