Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of the 6th instant, No. 86A, advising as to desire of Mr. J. Widsten, the fishery guardian at Bella Coola, to be given permission to erect a building for the protection of the motor boats stationed at Bella Coola belonging to the Department of Marine and Fisheries and in reply to say that, providing the Indians give their consent and the applicant pays whatever is considered reasonable for the privilege, permission may be given, to continue during pleasure, for erection of this building on the Bella Coola Reserve.
