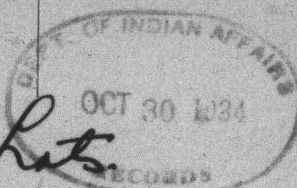

Indian Agent's Collection Report

October 26th 1934

Charles Prince, refuses to make further payments or carry on the Contract at the present price, which was sold on his own offer at \$31.00 per acre, but he states that condition and land prices have changed and adjoining improved farms can be had at \$20.00 an acre and he is willing to take it on at this price and meet the Payments. It would certainly be advisable to let it go at \$20.00 an acre and he is a substantial Farmer, who can pay for it.
