
Ottawa, 23rd June, 1910.

Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 17th instant reporting the resignation of Farmer Williamson and asking authority to employ a man you have in view, a Scotchman about 34 years of age, married, who has been in Ontario and the West for some 12 years and has been at farm work all his life, is sober, honest and has a good public school education.

In reply I beg to say that as you think he will prove satisfactory you may employ him on probation at \$40.00 per month and the usual rations, and if his services prove satisfactory and he is retained in the service, his wages will be increased \$10.00 a month in a year's time.
