## SUMMING UP BY JA



- 1. Duty of JA to advise on law.
- 2. Court is sole judge of facts.
- 3. Credibility of witnesses is for Court. May believe or disbelieve whole or part of a witness's evidence.
- 4. Accused innocent until proven guilty.
- 5. Burden of proof is on Prosecution.
- 6. Accused entitled to benefit of reasonable doubt.
- 7. Reasonable doubt defined.
- 8. Desertion is absence without leave coupled with intention of quitting the service entirely or of avoiding some important particular service.
- 9. Must be satisfied accused had knowledge of the particular service and intended to avoid it. Intent may be inferred from acts of accused.
- Court may find accused guilty of desertion or guilty of AWL or may acquit him.
- 11. Refers to RP 44(D).
- 12. President, Prosecutor and Defending Offr state they wish nothing added to JA's direction.
