With reference to your letter of August 24th, we would again advise that two-thirds of the profits derived from the sale of timber under contract logging must be credited to the Band Trust Account, the remaining one-third to be distributed on a per capita basis to all Band members approved by the Department.

A statement to this effect must be included in the Band resolution requesting the timber permit.
