An Appeal for the Care and Training of Feeble-Minded Persons, and a Plea for the Formation of Leagues for the Protection of the Feeble-Minded in All Parts of Nova Scotia.

In May, 1908, a number of persons held a meeting in Halifax and formed an organization known as the Nova Scotia League for the Care and Protection of the Feeble-minded. This League now numbers among its members 150 residents of Halifax and Dartmouth, and it is expected that during the immediate future the membership will be greatly increased.
