But this order of business may be changed by a majority of the meeting.

XXXI. The Secretary shall furnish for all meetings an alphabetical list of the members qualified and entitled to vote.

INTERNAL ECONOMY.

XXXII. The Club house shall be open Club hours. every day for the reception of members at 7.30 o'clock a.m., and shall be closed and lights extinguished at 1 a.m., except on Saturdays and Sundays, when the hour of closing shall be midnight, and no member shall be admitted into the Club after these hours on any pretence whatever, unless specially authorized by the Committee.

XXXIII. No member shall take away from the Club, upon any pretence whatsoever, any newspaper, pamphlet, book, map, or other article, the property of the Club, unless upon such terms as may be decided upon by the Committee. No papers to be taken away.

XXXIV. No servant of the Club shall be sent out of the house upon any errand, on any pretence whatever, except by the sanction and order of the Secretary or Stewart, nor shall any member give any money or gratuity to any of the servants upon any pretence whatever. No servants sent out on errands.

XXXV. No article of furniture, plate, china, linen, or other Club property shall be taken out of the Club at any time. No property of Club to be taken out.
