Mr. *Bourassa* moved, in amendment, seconded by Mr. *Dorion* (*Drummond* and *Arthabaska*), That all the words after "now" to the end of the Question, be left out; and the words "re-committed to a Committee of the Whole House with instructions to leave out the fifth clause, which provides that Banks shall not hereafter be liable to any penalty or forfeiture for usury under the ninth section of chapter fifty-eight of the "Consolidated Statutes of Canada" inserted instead thereof.
