CAP. XX.

*AN ACT to provide for the Contingent Expenses
of the Legislature.*

[Passed 14th June, 1852.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the Contingent Expenses of the Legislature during the present Session : Preamble.

Be it therefore enacted, by the Governor, Council and Assembly, in Legislative Session convened, That from and out of such Monies as shall from time to time remain in the hands of the Treasurer, and unappropriated, there be granted to Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, the Sum of Four Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-two Pounds, Nineteen Shillings and Eleven Pence, to be applied towards remunerating the Officers of the Legislature for their services, and towards defraying the Contingent Expenses of Her Majesty's Council and the House of Assembly during the present Session, as follows :

The Clerk of Her Majesty's Council, for his services during the present Session, One Hundred and Fifty Pounds ; and a further sum of Twenty-five Pounds for extra services owing to the length of the present Session of the Legislature. Officers of Council

The Master-in-Chancery attending Her Majesty's Council, for his services during the present Session, One Hundred Pounds ; and a further sum of Twenty-five Pounds for Extra Services owing to the length of the present Session of the Legislature.

The Usher of the Black Rod, for his services during the present Session, Eighty-five Pounds ; and a further sum of Twenty-five Pounds owing to the length of the present Session of the Legislature.

The Doorkeeper of Her Majesty's Council for his services during the present Session, Forty-five Pounds ; and a further sum of Five Pounds for extra services owing to the length of the present Session of the Legislature.
