Our Recipes

Pineapple Sponge

Place in the upper part of the double boiler one pint of milk, and when it is hot add a pinch of salt, a heaping tablespoonful of sugar and a little minced candied orange peel. Cook over hot water for five minutes, then stir in a third of a box of gelatine (that has been soaked in half a cup of cold water), and stir until the gelatine is dissolved. Remove from the fire, and when almost cold beat with an egg beater. Then fold in a large cupful of flaked pineapple (drained), and pour into a ring mould and set in the icebox to chill and harden. Serve unadorned on a glass platter and pour over a whipped cream sauce.

Peanut Wafers

Beat to a stiff froth two eggs and add half a cupful of sugar, a pinch of salt, a saltspoonful of grated nutmeg, two tablespoonfuls of melted butter, one large cupful of chopped peanuts and one teaspoonful of baking powder sifted with sufficient flour to form a dough that can be rolled out. Roll out on the pastry board into a thin sheet and cut into small circles. Bake until crisp and brown in a hot oven.
