A homesteader who has axhauste his bomestesd right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may enter for a purchas d homestead in certain districts. Price \$1.00 per acre. Duties.—Muet reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$300.00.
