RHODES SCHOLARSHIP, 1912.

The Qualifying Examination for this Scholarship will be held in the Colonial Building, on Tuesday, October 17th, and Wednesday, October 18th, next.

Candidates for Examination are requested to have their applications lodged with the undersigned not later than Saturday, the 14th of October.

The accompanying extract from a letter received from Dr. Parkin of the Rhodes Trust is published for the information of intending candidates.

"By a recent decree of Oxford University it is now possible for a candidate who may have passed the Rhodes Qualifying Examination in Latin and Mathematics, but not in Greek, to remove the Greek 'condition' by passing in that language at some subsequent Rhodes Qualifying Examination.

For example, a candidate who may have passed in Latin and Mathematics in October, 1909, may offer himself at the Examination of October, 1910 for Examination in Greek only; and, if he pass, will not be required to pass in Responsions Greek at Oxford."
