season, and likely more if rain comes soon to soften the ground. Every settler is having as much land broken as possible, so that he may be able to commence growing crops. They are not at all discouraged by the lack of noisture this spring, and say that they often experienced drier seasons than this in Dakota and Minnesota and have the fullest confidence that the re-quired moisture will come in due time. "A country that will grow such crops of wild grass" said one of the new comers to me, "will grow good crops of grain if properly cultivated and as far as I am concerned I have not the slightest doubt but that farming will be a success here."
