**Bill Introduced in the Legislature to Give a Subsidy to the N. & S. Railway.**

**Ten Thousand Two Hundred and Forty Acres to the Mile—Conditions Imposed.**

**His Honor the Lieutenant-Governor, yesterday, sent down to the Legislature a bill (No. 76) to authorize the granting of a certain land subsidy for, and in aid of the Nelson and Port Sheppard Railway.**

**The provisions of the bill, are as follows, viz:—**

**Sec. 1. To grant to the said company lands in West Kootenay not exceeding 10,240 acres for each mile of railway to be constructed by the company, upon condition of their commencing and constructing the Nelson and Port Sheppard Railway within the time and according to the terms of their Act of Incorporation, and upon the further condition that the company shall deposit security for such construction in the manner hereinafter mentioned.**

**Sec. 2. Upon the company filing with the Chief Commissioner of Lands and Works a map or plan, showing the course and direction of the proposed railway and the lands intended to be traversed, and upon depositing with the Provincial Secretary good and sufficient security in the sum of \$25,000 as liquidated and ascertained damages due to Her Majesty in right of the Province of British Columbia in case of default for the due commencement and construction of the railway according to their Act of Incorporation, there shall be reserved from pre-emption and sale a tract of land extending sixteen miles on each side of the line of the proposed railway.**

**Sec. 3. Within one year after the passage of this Act the company shall define and project, in a manner satisfactory to the Chief Commissioner of Lands and Works, a plan of the location of the railway, the boundary line of alternate blocks of land fronting upon each side of the line of the said railway, and having a frontage of six miles on each side of the line of the railway, so that such a block of land shall be a similar block not selected by the company on the Cariboo road, with a view of opening it, if they conclude it can be profitably worked.**
