

SALVOR WITH SURVIVORS

Boat Returned Yesterday Afternoon With Two Men Who Succeeded in Escaping Fearful Death on the Doomed Steamer Valencia

SIXTEEN OF THE BODIES ARE RECOVERED

Dominion Government Orders Investigation into the Wreck—Tug Bahada With Fishing Dories Is Searching for More Bodies.

STEAMER *Salvor* returned from the wreck last evening with two survivors; the United States revenue cutter *Albatross* reached Seattle last night with eleven survivors and three bodies; while the tug *Bahada* with two fishing dories is endeavoring to recover the others driven ashore near the scene of the wreck which cannot be taken over the difficult cutter trail. Sixteen bodies had been recovered up to last evening, five being identified, and search is being continued for others.

The *Salvor* brought Frank Connors, a waiter, and George Long, fireman, to Victoria, and both were immediately removed to the marine hospital, as they are suffering severely from bodily bruises and swollen from exposure.

Connors was for a time in danger of losing his reason. When the raft on which he drifted to Turret Island, in Barkley Sound, with seven others, of whom four became mad, one so violent that he had to be restrained by his fellow victims, the latter, under the influence of the hallucinations that he had seen a lighthouse, wandered off into the bush, where he almost died before he was found a day later by an expedition from the steamer *Salvor*, when he was lying on a log muttering and almost insane. Long was also on that raft.

Both men had a frightful experience after leaving the vessel, not the least shocking of it being when the steamer *Albatross* came to the rescue. The *Salvor* was found by the *Albatross*, which they took to be the *Queen*, and saw the steamer sheer away, leaving them to drift at the mercy of the waves until they drifted ashore, with four of their company raving maniacs and before death came to them.

F. P. Bunker and the other survivors who made their way over the trail, suffering such hardships, were transferred to the United States revenue cutter *Albatross*, which was carrying the *Salvor's* crew. Bunker was loudly praised by his fellows, he being a man of great vigor and bravery. When he reached Bamfield he was clad only in his trousers and had boots tied with a piece of string to his feet. His hands and his nude shoulders were covered by a piece of blanket, he having given his two shirts to fellow survivors. From this party the *Albatross* returned, learned that the signals seen on shore by the tug *Lorne*, and the *Albatross's* blue jackets were which the *Albatross's* blue jackets were sent to endeavor to make a landing on Thursday, were not those of further survivors, having been taken by the *Albatross* on board the tug *Bahada*, which was carrying the *Salvor's* crew. This disposes of the belief that others escaped, and the total number of survivors is shown to have been but 37 of the total on board the steamer of 154 persons.

The survivors who drifted into Barkley Sound on a raft, speak slightly of the bravery of both the steward and stewardess and their department. They say that before the wreck the vessel was engaged constantly in passing food to all, and long after the crew took to the rigging the steward and his wife passed up meat and sandwiches to those lashed in the cordage of the wreck.

Terrible Storm Raging
The night of Tuesday, when the shipwrecked people were in the rigging, was a terrible one, a storm blowing which was almost responsible for the loss of the steamer *Salvor*, which had sailed from Victoria on Sunday last. The *Salvor* put into Bamfield on Wednesday morning and Captain Munro reported that on Tuesday night the sealing schooner was within a few yards of being wrecked on Cape Beale, and if she had not cleared the point her company of 24 would doubtless have been all lost. When the sealers took of the storm, which Captain Munro said was one of the worst he had experienced, those at Bamfield thought that none of the people in the rigging of the steamer would have survived that night. But they did. That same day a telephone message was received from Lineman Logan and the party which went by the land trails to the wreck from Cloose, and the linemen told a tragic tale of seeing the steamer *Salvor* on Wednesday morning, carrying away all who had survived the terrors of the previous night.

The three shots heard by those on the steamer *Queen* as she stood by the wreck on Wednesday were the sounds of the attempts made to throw lines ashore.

Search Parties Being Organized
Before long the wreckage began to sweep on to the rocks, and then the first five bodies were found. Bodies, casks and all manner of freight was then washed ashore, and the Nitinat Indians and those of Cloose and Pachaena have since been busy gathering what they can. The Nitinat Indians propose to hold a potlatch in a few days with the goods they have secured. The parties at the scene are preventing any looting, however. The government agents are organizing parties of Indians to search for bodies, especially in the Barkley Sound direction and near Uchelet, where it is expected that the majority of the bodies will be recovered, as the tide sets in that direction. Yesterday afternoon a despatch from Uchelet reported the finding of a body on Frickett Island, west of Turret Island, in the Broken group, and the correspondent at Cape Beale, Erickson of Oelwein, Iowa, having been located near Cape Beale.

The Dominion government has decided to hold an investigation into the wreck of the *Valencia*, and as a result of this it is considered that the question of better protection and recovery of bodies from Vancouver Island will be gone into fully and steps taken to secure the necessary arrangements. Captain Peterson, the local agent of the marine and fisheries, has not yet been advised of arrangements for the enquiry. It is doubtful if a coroner's inquest will be held here, now that the bodies recovered are being sent to Seattle. The government enquiry will answer this purpose.

U. S. Grant Taking a Hand
The tug *Bahada* reached Bamfield Creek last night with Captain Patterson of the Pacific Coast Steamship Company on board the tug, which was picked up at Neah Bay, together with some dories which will be used, as fishermen mending. The revenue cutter *Grant* was standing at the scene of the wreck when the *Bahada* arrived, and two officers and a passenger from the *Valencia*, as well as some men from the *Bahada*, made a landing near the scene of the wreck, and the bodies found. Before these could be taken into the dories the sea began to rise, and they were obliged to make landings in order to get through the surf.

Bunker, the Seattle assistant school superintendent, who survived the disaster and who has been energetic in his work since reaching shore, offered his services to patrol the beaches if the government would allow him to. He said bodies were being washed in all along the shore, but it was only possible to search at low water.

Colonist Man Home
After having spent four days in the vicinity of the wreck of the *Valencia*, and witnessing many instances of great suffering, the *Colonist* correspondent on the *Salvor* arrived home last evening. In recounting his experiences, Mr. Logan said he first heard of the wreck about 2.45 on Tuesday, and was instructed to take passage on the *Salvor*, which was to leave before dawn. He hurried to Esquimalt and was taken aboard. At this time hardly any of the crew of the *Salvor* had been recovered, they were going or what they were going to. They were soon made aware of the terrible disaster and all were anxious to get out and render any assistance possible. Shortly after this H. F. Bullen, Capt. Troup, Supt. C. P. R. Steam-

ship Co.; Capt. J. G. Cox, Lloyd's agent, Dr. Hart and Dr. Richmond came aboard and the *Salvor*, in Charge of Captain Harris and Ferris of the Princess Mary, left Esquimalt at 5.50 for the scene of the disaster. Race Rocks were passed in safety and the majority retired to be called at 1 a.m. if there was anything to report. A brief look was kept all the way from Race Rocks to Carmanah, the latter being passed before 1 o'clock. The rain was coming down in torrents and the sea was running very high and in order that the wreck would not be passed in the dark the *Salvor* was turned into the straits. The passengers were all called about 5.30 a.m. and a large vessel was passed shortly after 6 o'clock. The *Queen* was not spoken. The *Queen* was in sight most of the night, and was again sighted also on the west coast of Vancouver Island. The *Salvor* saw a very pretty picture with all her lights burning. She only proceeded in a short distance, when she again put around and proceeded down the coast. The *Queen* was the first to reach Carmanah, and received the signal that the wreck was on Seal Islands. She then proceeded seaward and spoke the *Salvor*, the *Salvor* in the meantime trying to signal Carmanah. While thus engaged the *Salvor* came within hailing distance and gave the information that the *Queen* had sighted the wreck. The *Salvor* then gave the location of the wreck. Till this time both vessels were not aware of the exact location of the wreck, owing to the message that was received in Victoria saying that the wreck was four miles west of Carmanah. On receipt of this information all three vessels made for the wreck with all possible speed but about two miles were lost. The *Salvor* and *Queen* stood by till the *Salvor* and *Queen* arrived. It was still raining hard and blowing a body on Frickett Island, not long before Capt. Harris called out "There she is." Many eager eyes were strained to catch a glimpse of her, but only at times was she to be seen, as the breakers were continually dashing over her. A terrible sea was running and through the glasses the spray was seen to cover even the masts. The *Queen* stood out from the shore and the *Salvor* was in closer, while the *Queen* was still closer.

From the *Salvor* all that was seen of the wreck was her two masts and her deck. After having taken a look at the wreck, the *Salvor* was ordered to return to her own safety. The *Queen* turned out and reported to both the *Queen* and *Salvor* that there were signs of life, but whether or any person was in the rigging it was impossible to say.
