

# The Verb TO BE With an Adjective.

## INDICATIVE MOOD.

### *Present and Past.*

- Sin. 1. Chin-gest, I am good. 2.  
Ku-gest. 3. Gest.  
Pl. Kac-gest. 2. P-gest. 3.  
Gest.

### *Future.*

- Sin. 1. Nem chin-gest, I will be  
good. 2. Nem ku-gest, etc.  
By adding *nem* to the present.  
STBJUNCTIVE MOOD.

### *Present.*

- Sin. 1. Chiks-gesti, I must, will,  
can be good. 2. Kuks-gesti,  
3. Ks-gesti.  
Pl. Kaeks-gesti. 2. P-ks-gesti,  
3. Ks-gesti.

### *Past.*

- Sin. Lu lshei u chin-gest, When  
I was good.

### *Future 1st.*

- Sin. 1. Ne chin-gest, When I  
shall be good.

### *Future 2d.*

- Sin. Ne chiks-gest, When I shall  
want, be able to be good.

### *Future 3d.*

- Nem chiks-gest, I shall be able,  
etc. to be good.

## CONDITIONAL MOOD.

### *Past.*

- Ku lu (or ku) chin-gest, etc. As  
in paradigm (1).

## OPTATIVE MOOD.

### *Present, Past and Future.*

- Komi-chin-gest, Would to God  
that I be good, that I had been  
good.

### *Future.*

- Komi-chiks-gest, Would to God  
that I be able to be good.

## INFINITE MOOD.

### *Present.*

- Sin. Lu i-sgest, My being good.

### *Past.*

- Lu i-sz-gest, My having been  
good.

### *Future 1st.*

- Lu ik-sgest, My future being  
good.

### *Future 2d.*

- Lu ik-sz-gest My having been  
able to be good.
