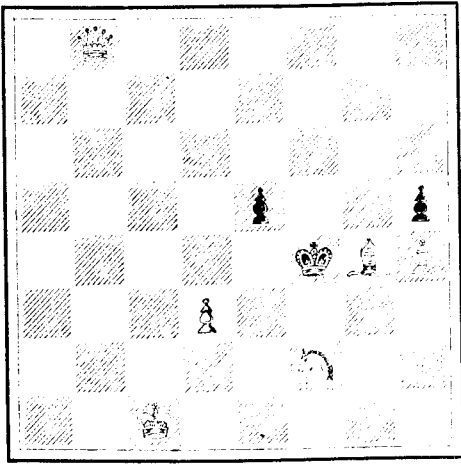

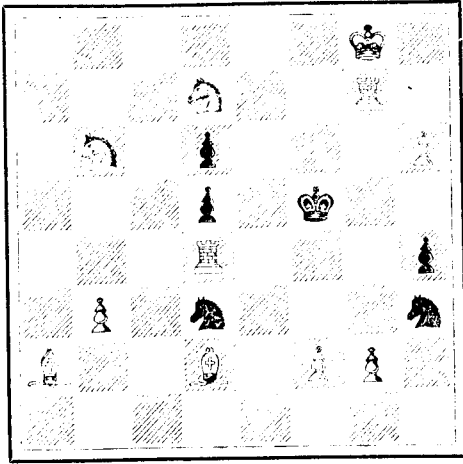

NOTES BY GUNSBURG.

- (a) The game so far is on ordinary lines. This move does not improve White's development. (b) The right reply to White's inactive move. (c) If Black play now B x B then Kt will remain badly posted, and is a loss of time in any event. (d) Another inactive move, while Black develops his game. (e) This does not seem profitable. (f) Good introduction to an attack, viz., P-K Kt 4, etc. (g) White threatened to Castle on Q side followed by R-K Kt 1. B's advance is just in time. (h) It is difficult to suggest a better move. (i) Black boldly runs the risk of isolated Pawns in case of an end game. (j) P-B 4 would lead to interesting complications in which Black could give up the Kt. (k) Black threatened R x B P, etc. (l) An excellent move by which Black gains a substantial advantage. (m) Safe and sound; Kt x Q P most tempting but less reliable. (n) A neat ending and in harmony with Black's play throughout.

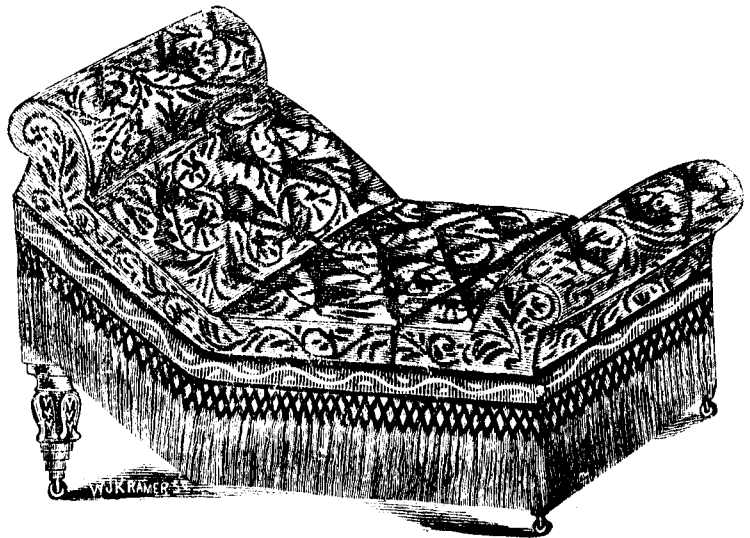

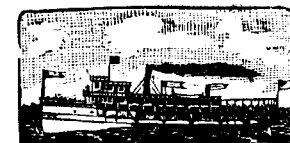
