The Government of Canada and the Government of the State of Bahrain,

Out of the ties of friendship and co-operation, and as a result of the present unsettled conditions in the Gulf area, which threaten the security and safety of Bahrain, and other countries in the region, and in recognition of the grave breach of the peace of the region and of United Nations Security Council Resolutions 660, 661, 662, 664, and 665 have agreed as follows:
