NEW ZEALAND DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER VISITS OTTAWA

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, Dr. Mark MacGuigan, has invited the Honourable Brian E. Talboys, New Zealand Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Foreign Affairs and Minister of Overseas Trade, to visit Ottawa August 21.

While in Ottawa Mr. Talboys will meet with Dr. MacGuigan and other ministers to discuss a number of issues which are of interest to both Canada and New Zealand as trading nations and as countries of the Pacific. He will particularly review with Dr. MacGuigan and with Ed Lumley, Minister of State for Trade, means of strengthening the broad spectrum of private and government relations in order to expand economic and trade cooperation between the two countries.

During his stay in Canada Mr. Talboys will be travelling to British Columbia, from August 15-17, Alberta, August 18-19, Manitoba, August 19-20, Ontario, August 21-22, and Quebec, August 23-24, for discussions with provincial ministers and business leaders. He will leave Canada for New York on August 24th.
