

Resolution to be reported.

The said resolution was reported and concurred in.

Mr. Fulton, seconded by Mr. Green, by leave of the House, presented a Bill, No. C-59, An Act to amend the Judges Act, which was read the first time.

By unanimous consent, the said Bill was read the second time, considered in Committee of the Whole, reported without amendment, read the third time and passed.

The Order being read for the second reading of Bill No. C-56, An Act to authorize the Construction of a Bridge across Lubec Channel between the Province of New Brunswick and the State of Maine;

Mr. Green, seconded by Mr. Brooks, moved,—That the said Bill be now read a second time.

After debate thereon, the question being put on the said motion, it was agreed to.

The said Bill was accordingly read the second time, considered in Committee of the Whole and reported without amendment.

By unanimous consent, the said Bill was read the third time and passed.

The House resolved itself again into Committee of Supply.
