

On motion of the Honourable Mr. Tanner, it was—

Ordered, That an Order of the Senate do issue for a Return showing:—

1. On what dates during 1923 and 1924 did the Chief Inspector of Customs and Excise Department visit the cities of Toronto, Montreal, Winnipeg, Quebec and Vancouver, respectively, for inspectorial purposes.

2. On what dates, during 1923 and 1924, did any assistant inspector from the Chief Inspector's office at Ottawa visit the said cities respectively for inspectorial purposes.

3. Who were the assistant inspectors who made the visits.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the Senate proceeded to the consideration of the second Report of the Standing Committee on Divorce, to whom was referred the petition of Jessie Louise Cowan, together with the evidence taken before the said Committee.

The said Report was, on division, adopted.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the Bill (3), intituled: "An Act to amend the Criminal Code (Printer's Liability)," was read the second time, and—

On motion, it was—

Referred to a Special Committee of this House, composed of the Honourable Messieurs: Beaubien, Belcourt, Dandurand, McMeans, Pardee, Planta, Ross (Middleton) and Willoughby.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the Senate resumed the further adjourned debate on the motion of the Right Honourable Sir George Foster:—

That an humble Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General; praying that His Excellency will cause to be laid before the Senate a copy of the Geneva Protocol, of the report thereon submitted by the Committees of the fifth Assembly of the League of Nations, and of the proceedings of the said Assembly detailing the discussion and action taken in regard thereto, and copies of all correspondence between the Government of Canada and the Government of Great Britain or any members thereof, in relation thereto.

After debate, and—

On motion of the Honourable Mr. Robertson, it was—

Ordered, That further debate on the said motion be adjourned until Thursday, next.
