

aboriginal group, they, as another early priority, resolve the issues of equality and membership.

Finally, your Committee is of the opinion that, when amendments to the Constitution are being proposed it is extremely important that the authorized representatives of the people in both the federal and provincial spheres have the time to consider and debate fully the implications of any change. Your

Committee therefore recommends to the governments involved that such proposed amendments be tabled before the appropriate legislative bodies at the earliest possible moment in order to give them the consideration they require.
