On behalf of the University of Western Ontario, I desire to thank you for your kindness in helping us with the Memorial Service on Friday, the 17th instant.


Please accept our congratulations upon the excellence of your address which was probably the finest effort that our people have been privilege to hear. Everyone who was present has spoken of it in the highest terms.
