BY-LAWS.

I.—Candidates for membership shall be proposed by a member, and seconded by an office-bearer, or one of the Committee—the confirmation on the part of the President or Secretary of such nomination shall constitute membership.

II.—After election members shall only enjoy the privileges of such when they have signed the By-Laws and paid their subscriptions to the Treasurer. Each member shall be required to pay the Annual subscription as long as his name remains on the list, and he shall have no power to withdraw his name (unless prior to the Annual General Meeting) he shall forward to the Secretary his written request to do so.

III.—Any person subscribing to the Constitution and By-Laws, and paying, in advance, an annual subscription of One Dollar (\$1) may become a member of the Society. No person who shall not have paid such annual subscription, on or before the Annual Meeting, shall be entitled to vote in any of the affairs of the Society.

IV.—An Annual General Meeting shall be held on the second Saturday of January, when the Secretary shall be required to furnish in writing a report of the transactions of the Club for the past
