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find it very inconvenient to be in Advance for
the whole, tho every one's share will be but
a trifle.

The following is a matter, that
concerns the public interest.

The 11th & 12th years of King William

obvious act of disobedience, than for the

sales in a manner, that was inconsistent
and contrary to the Act, by which alone
they could proceed in any such measure,
and by which they profess to proceed.

of by Government here, in order to screen
