

HOLY TRINITY, NEW WESTMINSTER.

Commencing at the westerly line of the suburban lots of the City of New Westminster, where it intersects the north bank of the Fraser River; thence following the limits of said suburban lots to the intersection of a line running due north from the north-west corner of the Penitentiary reserve; thence following the said line southerly to the north-west corner of the said reserve; thence following the line of the Glen Creek southerly to the Fraser River; thence following the north bank of the Fraser River to the place of beginning.

ST. MARY'S, SAPPERTON.

Commencing at the head of Pitt Lake; thence following through the centre of Pitt Lake and River to the Fraser River; thence following the north bank of the Fraser River to the mouth of the Glen Creek; thence following the Glen Creek northerly to the northwest corner of the Penitentiary reserve; thence following a line drawn due north from that corner. Douglas Island to be included in this Parish.

ST. JOHN THE DIVINE, MAPLE RIDGE.

Commencing at the head of Pitt Lake; thence following the centres of Pitt Lake and Pitt River to the Fraser River; thence following the channel of the Fraser River to the easterly boundary of the Parish of All Saints, Trenant; thence south to the boundary line; thence east to the line between Townships 13 and 16; thence north along the line between Townships 13 and 16, 14 and 17, 15 and 13.

ST. THOMAS, CHILLIWACK.

Commencing at the north-east corner of Township 13; thence south to the boundary line; thence east along said boundary line to a point six miles east of the south-east corner of Township No. 25; thence north.

ST. JOHN'S, VALE.

This Parish shall include all between a line drawn north from a point six miles east of the south-east corner of Township 25 on the west; the boundary line on the south; a line due north and south drawn through the eastern limit of Boston Bar on the east; and a line due west and east drawn through the northern limit of Boston Bar on the north.

LYTTON.

This Parish shall include all those places usually served from Lytton, including Kamloops.
