FLORENCE CO. LOSE APPEAL Privy Council Decline to Interfere

Big Cobalt Deal. dicial committee of the privy council has lismissed with costs the appeal of the Florence Mining Company v. Cobalt Lake Mining Company.

Arrangements are already being made for the installation of a new equipment, with the result that the mills should be in full operation by the beginning of May, and in this way permit the company to treat all the ore that it can take from its various pits.
